

The Saint Agnes Healthcare Hearing Aid Program is as easy as 1, 2, 3.

- 1. Have a hearing test. All you need is a written order from your doctor. If you've had a hearing test in the past 12 months, the audiologist will simply need to review it.
- **2. Have a hearing aid evaluation.** This is where you, your significant other, and the audiologist work together to determine what style, technology, and features will work best for you.
- **3. 30-day trial period.** This allows you time to ensure your comfort with the fit, style, and performance of the hearing aids.

Hearing Aid Technology

There are two types: Digital and Analog.

Digital hearing aids provide greater flexibility to meet the needs of demanding environments. Digital sound processors divide incoming sounds into 14 adjustable frequency bands for improved speech clarity and listening comfort.

Analog hearing aids provide the same gain for incoming speech and background noise. A volume wheel is standard for making loudness adjustments.

Hearing Aid Style

Your individual style is important. We understand this and provide our patients with a complete range of hearing aid styles from completely-in-the-canal to mini behind-the-ear to open fit technology.

Digital Hearing Aid Features

- Adaptive and automatic directionality of speech: to focus on listening in a crowded room.
- Automatic noise reduction: helps reduce background noise without impacting the conversation.
- Wind noise management.
- Active feedback elimination: whistle-free hearing instrument.
- Up to four listening programs for different situations and environments.
- Telecoil feature for improved telephone use: compatible with select Bluetooth and FM devices.
