NEW PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

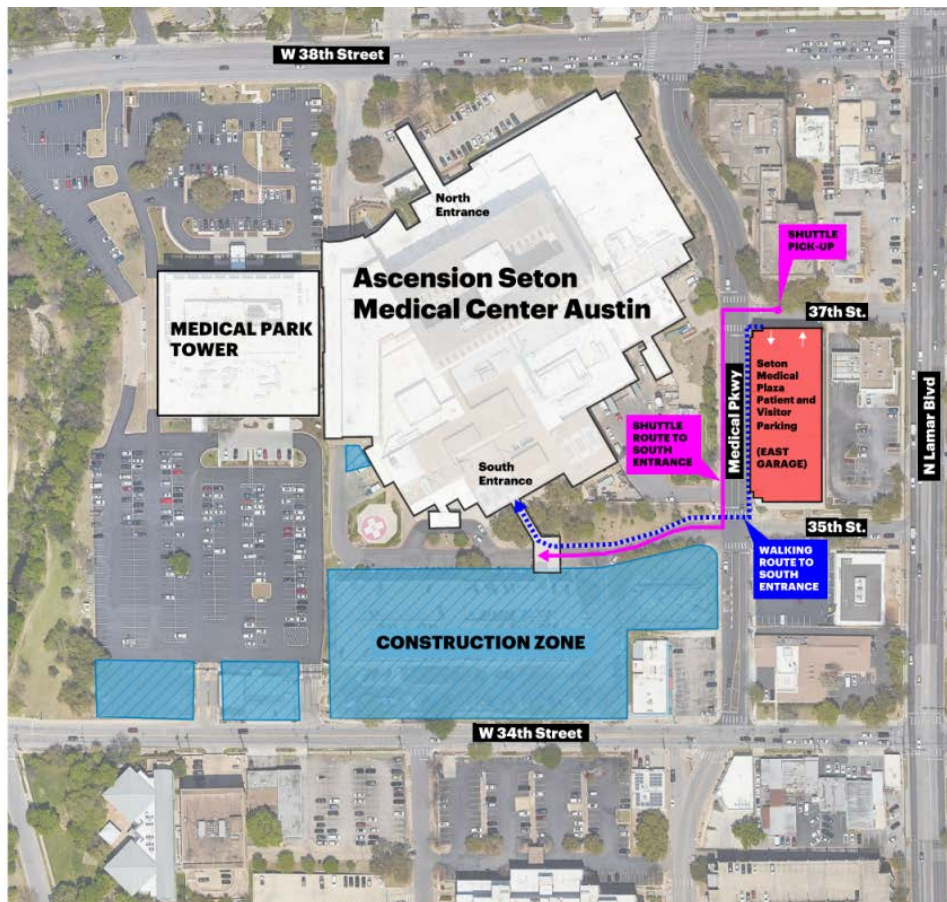
During construction of the new Women’s Tower and Garage, Ascension Seton has provided temporary parking for our patients and visitors, available in our **Seton Medical Plaza Patient and Visitor Garage** (also known as Austin Medical Plaza or East Garage), located at 1015 37th street, Austin, TX. For your convenience, a shuttle service will be available for transportation to and from the hospital between the hours of 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. The garage is a 3 minute walk or approximately 0.1 miles from the hospital’s South entrance.
